NEW BUSINESS:

Township resident Richard McFarlane would like to bring electric service to his property 002-25, on Cheeseman Road, he would have to cross parcel 003-00 owned by Richard Wagner, which is protected by a conservation easement. The conservation easement was put into effect in April 2001, and proved by Wagner directly to Moran Township. The easement provided to the township encumbered the property in both general and specific way to protect conservation and scenic values. Opinion by township Attorney Evashevski, states the general concept of most conservation easements, including this particular easement, is to prohibit development that would alter the appearance of a natural setting.

While the conservation easement would prohibit either an overhead or underground electrical installation, the township owns the easement and has the authority to grant exceptions if it so chooses. Therefore, if the township, through its board, wishes to provide an exception from the easement, it may do so.

MOTION BY SPENCER, SECONDED BY HEUER (CARRIED) TO ALLOW RICHARD MCFARLANE TO PUT TEMPORARY ELECTRICAL SERVICE TO HIS PROPERTY ON CHEESEMAN ROAD AND HAVE PERMANENT POWER PUT UNDERGROUND BY JUNE 1, 2009. ALSO WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM RICHARD WAGNER. IN ADDITION, PROVE LEGAL DRIVEWAY ACCESS OFF CHEESEMAN ROAD TO HIS PROPERTY.
